OVERVIEW STATEMENT

The Asset Project Office (APO) plans, manages and executes the delivery and transition of newly acquired Coast Guard assets to operational service in the field. The APO transitions assets from acquisition to sustainment safely and effectively, with minimal impact on the operators and maintainers in the field. The APO also provides systems engineering and integration, business process support and decision-making analysis.

To accomplish its mission, the APO manages the development of integrated logistics support plans and products; defines resource requirements for staffing asset product lines and associated billets; trains, develops and directs prospective product lines; and provides subject matter expertise.

The APO is aligned within the Coast Guard Acquisition Directorate to provide full-time commitment to developing acquisition logistics. This new model allows for continual improvement through the application of lessons learned. The APO provides a total enterprise perspective through use of in-house, cross-functional experts and dedicated subject matter experts. It prepares product lines for sustainment, providing critical continuity for lifecycle support of assets.

The APO is currently working on several Coast Guard product lines, including the Offshore Patrol Cutter and the following:
