Subj: ANNUAL COAST GUARD INVITATIONAL GOLF TOURNAMENT

1. PURPOSE. The purpose of this Notice is to invite participation in the 2004 Annual Coast Guard Invitational Golf Tournament. Participation is open to all active duty, reserve, retired, auxiliary, and civilian personnel of the Coast Guard as well as military and civilian dependents and guests.
2. ACTION. Area and district commanders, commanders of maintenance and logistics commands, commanding officers of headquarters units, assistant commandants for directorates, Chief Counsel, and special staff offices at Headquarters shall give this notice widest dissemination.
3. DISCUSSION.
 - a. This year's tournament will be held at the Glade Springs Resort in Daniels, West Virginia from 2-5 June 2004. This is a U. S. Coast Guard Morale, Welfare, and Recreation (MWR) Category B event. The tournament will consist of one practice round on 2 June (including a team scramble event), followed by 3 days of individual stroke play.
 - b. Enclosures (1), (2) and (3) provide information about the Glade Springs Resort and tournament entry procedures. Entry forms may be locally reproduced.

GLADE SPRINGS RESORT AND TOURNAMENT PACKAGE INFO

THE RESORT

Glade Springs Resort is a 4,100 acre gated resort and community nestled among West Virginia's Allegheny Mountains, surrounded by breathtaking scenery and trails for walking, hiking, and horseback riding. Located on the resort are 2 championship golf courses, accommodations from mini-suites to multi-bedroom lodges and manor houses, a 4-star restaurant, a café and a lounge. Glade Springs Resort offers a variety of activities and outdoors recreation including fishing, hiking, biking, trail rides and rafting. Resort guests also have access to a full-service spa, a fitness center equipped with the latest aerobic and strength training equipment, and an indoor basketball court. A heated outdoor swimming pool offers a refreshing dip or an invigorating swim. Indoor and outdoor tennis courts stand ready for friendly competition.

The Cobb Course is an 18-hole championship course designed by George W. Cobb in the early 70's featuring rolling fairways framed by mature forest leading up to some of the largest greens and bunkers you'll probably ever play. Consistently ranked one of the best golf courses in West Virginia, The Cobb Course is considered one of the best of over 300 George Cobb designed courses. Glade Springs Resort has just completed a comprehensive upgrade to this course, lengthening it to over 7,000 yards while maintaining the classic integrity of its original design. Along with the numerous aesthetic changes, championship tees have been added to all eighteen holes. In addition to the newly expanded teeing areas, several fairway bunkers have been strategically placed throughout the course. This course has over 200 feet of elevation change, 54 sand bunkers, eight lakes, ever-changing sun angles, and fairways that subtly – or suddenly – slope the "wrong" way. You'll quickly learn that every green has its own quirks and pin placements can make or break your score.

Stonehaven is the newest course designed by Ault, Clark & Associates, Ltd. and is also framed by mature forest. This extraordinary mountain course features tees of bent grass with lengths ranging from 7,200 yards from the back tees to 5,200 yards from the forward tees. Glade Springs' new 18-hole championship course complements the existing Cobb Course. Designed with non-returning nines, there is a halfway house at the turn, along with shelters at the farthest extremes of the routing. The topography is dramatic, featuring striking rock outcroppings, and a meandering path through a forest of mature oak, maple, beech and hickory along with an under story of huge rhododendrons. The course has some of the most spectacular holes in West Virginia, along with the greatest variety of par 3's and par 5's anywhere on the east coast.

ACCOMMODATIONS

There are a wide variety of types of accommodations available at the resort including mini-suites and multi-bedroom villas, lodges and manor houses.

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Inviting in decor, the accommodations feature spacious luxury with fully equipped kitchens, dining, and living areas, and generous baths. Resort check-in time is 3:00 PM; check out time is 11:00 AM. Early check-in and/or late check out are on an “as available” basis, and must be arranged by the individual tournament participants.

TOURNAMENT PACKAGE

The basic tournament package consists of the following:

- Accommodations for three nights (Wed through Fri). *(Additional nights, before or after the tournament, may be reserved by contacting the resort @ 800-634-5233*
- 4 rounds of golf with cart.
- Additional rounds are on a space available basis following the tournament rounds Thursday through Saturday. Cost is \$35 per golfer for 18 holes including cart.
- Range balls each day.
- Wednesday evening buffet at the Pavilion.
- An “Awards Banquet” buffet on Saturday afternoon at the Conference Center.
- All taxes and gratuities. (Note: It is appropriate to tip ball/bag attendants on your own).

Note: Accommodations include mini-suites and multi-bedroom villas, lodges, and manor houses. Tournament lodging costs are the same, regardless of the type of accommodation; the only difference in cost has to do with single or double occupancy. All accommodations have access to kitchen facilities and daily housekeeping service. All children sharing a room with parents receive free lodging.

REGISTRATION/REFUNDS

Reservations for this tournament are on a first come, first served basis since there will be a limited number of golfers that can be accommodated on the golf courses. All personnel wishing to participate (golfers and non-golfers) in this tournament must fill out an entry form and send it along with the appropriate entry fee to Dr. Mike Parnarouskis (see entry form).

On 1 April 2004, we must make our final commitment to the Glade Springs Golf Resort and release all lodging units not reserved. Therefore, to be considered, all entry forms and fees **must be received by 29 March 2004**. Entry forms received after 29 March will only be considered if lodging at the resort is available and if the maximum number of golfers has not been reached.

Cancellation Policy: After 30 April 2004, a portion of the deposit we pay to the resort will have to be forfeited. The closer to the tournament date that an entry is cancelled, the larger the forfeiture will be.

FORMAT OF PLAY

The tournament will consist of 54 holes of medal play. No handicaps will be used. The field will be flighted following the 2nd round (Friday). The 54-hole total score will determine all winners. The number of flights will be determined by the number of participants. Several prizes will be awarded in each flight. Prizes will also be awarded for other categories such as closest to the pins and longest drives, as funds will allow. No distinction will be made between the golfers, except that ladies will play from the red tees, and men will play from the white tees. The Scramble Event for Wednesday will be a separate team event and the scores during that day will not be considered for the remainder of the tournament.

1900 - Results of Thursday's rounds posted at the Clubhouse.

Friday, 4 June:

0800 - Shotgun start on the **Stonehaven** course.

1900 - Results of Friday's rounds and flight assignments posted at the Clubhouse.

Saturday, 5 June:

0800 - Shotgun start on the **Cobb** Course.

1100 - Check-out.

1330 - Awards Banquet at the Conference Center, all prizes awarded.

1700 - 2004 Tournament concludes.



Take exit 125 (Beaver Airport Exit)
Turn left onto 307 West
Go 2 miles to intersection and turn left onto
Route 19 South
Go 2.8 miles and Glade Springs Resort will be on
the left

From I-77 North:

Take exit 28 (Ghent Exit), at the end of the exit
ramp turn right, which will bring you to Route 19
Turn left onto Route 19 North
Go 10 miles and Glade Springs Resort will be on
the right

From I-77 South to I-64 East:

Take exit 125A (Beaver Exit) into Route 307 West
Go 2 miles to intersection and turn left onto Route 19 South
Go 2.8 miles and Glade Springs Resort will be on the left

From Yeager Airport in Charleston, WV:

Follow directions for I-77 South to I-64
