OPERATION ORDER
CCGD5 NO 17-84

Subj: OPERATION PENOBSCOT BAY

Ref: (a) OFCO No. 27-84; USCGC PENOBSCOT BAY
(b) COMDTINST 3501.3A

Time Zone: Use local time for all operations

Task organization:

- a. Commander, Fifth Coast Guard District
- b. Commander, Third Coast Guard District
- c. Commanding Officer, Coast Guard SUPRTCEN, Portsmouth, VA
- d. Commanding Officer, Coast Guard Yard
- e. Commanding Officer, USCGC PENOBSCOT BAY

1. Situation: USCGC PENOBSCOT BAY will be delivered by the Tacoma Boat Company to the Hampton Roads area in late November 1984. Reference (a) is and will continue to be in effect with this oporder to provide additional guidance.

2. Mission: To accept, outfit, and train USCGC PENOBSCOT BAY (WTGB 107) for unrestricted operations and transit to the Third Coast Guard District.

3. Execution:

a. Commander, Fifth Coast Guard District:

- (1) Coordinate and supervise this operation. Project Officer is LT H. A. BLACK. (osr)
- (2) Place USCGC PENOBSCOT BAY in an "In Commission, Active" status and assume operational control (OPCON) and advise Commandant. (osr)
- (3) Provide PENOBSCOT BAY with a small arms allowance in accordance with CG Ordnance Manual (COMDTINST M8000.2) (or)
- (4) Coordinate selected refresher training with Commander, Atlantic Area (COMLANTAREA). (or)
- (5) Assist PENOBSCOT BAY with the establishment of general mess. (fbr)

b. Commanding Officer, Support Center Portsmouth:

- (1) Provide storage space for a van containing outfit items.
- (2) Provide pier space and dockside services for USCGC PENOBSCOT BAY for the duration of her time in the Hampton Roads area.

c. Commanding Officer, USCGC PENOBSCOT BAY:

- (1) The Prospective Commanding Officer (PCO) will accept the vessel from the resident inspector and place PENOBSCOT BAY in "Inactive, pending placement in commission" status, and advise Commandant, Commander, Fifth Coast Guard District (CCGDFIVE), Commander, Third Coast Guard District (CCGDTHREE), and COMLANTAREA of this change.
- (2) Advise Commanding Officer, Coast Guard Yard (SICP) when ready to receive cutter outfit, and specify date and location for delivery.
- (3) Advise CCGDFIVE armory when ready to receive small arms and ammunition.
- (4) On completion of fitting out, advise CCGDFIVE that PENOBSCOT BAY is ready for commissioning. When placed in "In Commission, Active" status, assume operational status B-24, conduct individual ship exercises and make preparations for shakedown training. Change Operational Control (CHOP) to Fleet Training Unit Little Creek no later than 14 DEC 84 and conduct shakedown training as directed.
- (5) Advise CCGDFIVE (osr) upon completion of shakedown training, and when ready for sea.
- (6) When directed by CCGDFIVE, CHOP to Comlantarea and transit to CCGDTHREE.
- (7) While under the OPCON of CCGDFIVE and COMLANTAREA, submit movement reports (movereps) to the operational commander upon departure from and arrival at each port. When underway, position reports will be made to the operational commander at 0800 and 2000 local time daily.
- (7) Comply with the casualty reporting procedures in reference (b).

d. Commanding Officer, Coast Guard Yard:

- (1) Provide all materials to outfit PENOBSCOT BAY in accordance with the standard outfit list for WTGB class cutters. Deliver items at time and location specified by Commanding Officer, USCGC PENOBSCOT BAY. (SICP)

4. Administration and Logistics:

a. Commander, Fifth Coast Guard District:

- (1) Maintain PENOBSCOT BAY PRECOMDET personnel service records and provide associated administrative services. Transfer all personnel service records back to Commanding Officer, USCGC PENOBSCOT BAY prior to the vessel's departure. (p)
- (2) Provide technical and logistic support required while PENOBSCOT BAY is under CCGDFIVE OPCON. (p) (f) (e)

b. Commanding Officer, USCGC PENOBSCOT BAY:

- (1) Deliver service records to Commander, Coast Guard Group New York, upon arrival at Governor's Island.

5. Command and Signal: During precommissioning activities, PENOBSCOT BAY PRECOMDET will be under the administrative control of Commandant (G-OMR). When placed in "Inactive, pending placement in commission" status, CCGDTHREE will assume administrative control. When placed in commission, CCGDFIVE will assume operational control of the vessel. During transit to the Third District, COMLANTAREA will assume operational control. Upon arrival at Governor's Island, New York, NY, the vessel will be under the operational and administrative control of CCGDTHREE.
