SUBJ: COAST GUARD CUTTER PENOBSCOT BAY (WTGB 107) COMMISSIONING

1. The Cutter Penobscot Bay will be commissioned at 1400, 4 January 1985 at Omaha Pier, Governors Island, New York. The uniform for participants in the ceremony is Service Dress Blue Alpha. All other attendees will be wearing Service Dress Blue Bravo.
2. Presently invitations have been extended to several personnel both civilian and Coast Guard in the Port of New York. A list of personnel is attached as enclosure (1) for your review. Invitations have also been extended to several personnel outside the New York area. Invitees include various Coast Guard Headquarters representatives, the ships builder and several branches which were instrumental in acquisition of the cutter.
