

Private Aids to Navigation

INFORMATION AND REGULATORY MARKS

Markings: The vast majority of these marks are can buoys. They shall be white (Federal color number 27875) with orange (Federal color number 12197) retro-reflective bands and buoy warning symbols. The warning symbols shall be placed 180° apart.

Occasionally, there may be a need to light an information and regulatory mark. If lighted, the mark shall display a white light at the top.

- An open circle indicates a “Controlled” area.



- A cross, centered in the diamond shape, indicates an “Exclusion” area.



- An open diamond indicates a “Danger” area.
