Special Local Regulations; Marine Events in the Fifth Coast Guard District (USNA Blue Angels Air Show)

Notice is hereby given for the establishment of a regulated area, established under the Act of April 28, 1908, as amended, (33 U.S.C. 1233), which authorizes the Coast Guard to regulate marine events. The Commandant has issued regulations on this subject in Part 100 of Title 33, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR). Coast Guard responsibility and authority are broad and include events on, in and under the water.

As described in Title 33 CFR § 100.501, a regulated area is established for all waters of the Severn River, from shoreline to shoreline, bounded to the northwest by a line drawn from the south shoreline at latitude 39°00'38.02" N, longitude 076°31'01.49" W, thence to the north shoreline at latitude 39°00'52.7" N, longitude 076°30'46.01" W; this line is approximately 1,300 yards northwest of the U.S.-50 fixed highway bridge. The regulated area is bounded to the southeast by a line drawn from U.S. Naval Academy Light at latitude 38°58'39.5" N, longitude 076°28'49" W, thence southeast to a point 1,500 yards ESE of Chinks Point, MD at latitude 38°57'41" N, longitude 076°27'36" W, thence northeast to Greenbury Point at latitude 38°58'27.66" N, longitude 076°27'16.38" W. The effect will be to restrict vessel traffic on the Severn River and College Creek. The regulated area will be enforced both days, from 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. on May 19, 2015 and from 11:15 a.m. to 4 p.m. on May 20, 2015. However, if the circle and arrival cannot be conducted on Tuesday, May 20, 2014 due to inclement weather, the regulated area will be enforced from 9:30 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Wednesday, May 21, 2014. All coordinates reference (Datum NAD 1983). A "Commercial Vessel Spectator Zone" is located immediately adjacent to the temporary access channel, within a line connecting the following positions: 38°58'28" N, 076°28'11" W; thence to 38°58'35" N, 076°28'03" W; thence to 38°58'28" N, 076°27'50" W; thence to 38°58'23" N, 076°27'55" W; thence to the point of origin. Only commercial passenger vessels will be permitted within this designated on-water spectator area. All coordinates reference (Datum NAD 1983). See diagram on the reverse.

The Coast Guard Patrol Commander may forbid and control the movement of all vessels and persons in the regulated area. When hailed or signaled by an official patrol vessel, a vessel or person in the regulated area shall immediately comply with the directions given. Failure to do so may result in expulsion from the area, citation for failure to comply, or both. Persons desiring to transit the regulated area must first obtain authorization from the Captain of the Port Baltimore or his designated representative. To seek permission to transit the area, the Captain of the Port Baltimore and his designated representatives can be contacted at telephone number 410-576-2693 or on Marine Band Radio, VHF-FM channel 16 (156.8 MHz). All Coast Guard vessels enforcing this regulated area can be contacted on marine band radio VHF-FM channel 16 (156.8 MHz).

Coast Guard Patrol Commander means a commissioned, warrant, or petty officer of the U. S. Coast Guard who has been designated by the Commander, Coast Guard Sector Baltimore.

Official Patrol means any vessel assigned or approved by Commander, Coast Guard Sector Baltimore with a commissioned, warrant, or petty officer on board and displaying a Coast Guard ensign.



PENALTY: Vessels or persons violating this section may liable pursuant to 33 U.S.C. 1236.
