

28 Apr 1924 Transferred from US Navy at Philadelphia Navy Yard.  
14 Oct 1924 Commissioned at Philadelphia Navy Yard.  
21 Oct 1924 Arrived at permanent duty station in New London.  
24 Oct 1927 Transferred to Division Four, Destroyer Force.  
4 Feb 1928 Reported to USCG Academy in New London as Practice Ship.  
21 Dec 1928 Ordered to active duty with headquarters at New London.  
5 Jan 1929 Began cruising.  
1 Jun 1930 Transferred to Division Two, Destroyer Force at New York.  
23 Oct 1930 Ordered to Philadelphia Navy Yard.  
18 Nov 1930 Decommissioned and returned to US Navy at Philadelphia Navy Yard.

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
