Subj: GOVERNMENT VEHICLE OPERATORS AND QUALIFICATIONS

Ref: (a) Training, Techniques and Tactics for Multiple Vehicle Operations DOGINST
11200.1(series)
(b) Motor Vehicle Manual COMDTINST M11240.9 (series)

1. Required personnel training will be completed in accordance with Ref (a), during Multiple Vehicle Operations (MVO) evolutions. MVO procedures shall be followed, at a minimum when:

- a. Travelling a distance of 400 miles or greater
- b. During any mission with an assigned DOG DEPOD

2. The following JQR has been documented in enclosure (1):

- a. MVO Commander – “In charge” of MVO operations. Completes all requisite planning, movement and post MVO forms and checklists
- b. Spotter - Responsible to assist in the safe movement of vehicle/trailer combinations and shall be used whenever trailers are engaged in backing or close quarter maneuvering situations

3. Required driver’s safety training will be documented with the issuance of a U.S. Government Motor Vehicle Operator’s Identification Card (OF-346) in accordance with Ref (b), to members at MSST Anywhere (911XX) identified in enclosure (1):

4. The OF-346 includes the following endorsement by direction:

- a. General Purpose Vehicles – Requires initial familiarization to include includes all 15 passenger vans and other unit vehicles not intended for towing evolutions or other wised mentioned
- b. Truck Trailer Combinations – Requires completion of unit JQR to include all vehicles able to tow boat trailers and auxiliary trailers
- c. Emergency Vehicle – Requires federal or approved state EVOC course and may be required for Law Enforcement evolutions as directed by CO
- d. Commercial Driver’s License – Requires a state or equivalent level training for Gross Vehicle Combined Weight Rating (GVCWR) of 26,000 pounds or more

- e. Special Purpose Motorized Equipment (SPME) – Requires completion of specific unit PQS to include appropriate forklift training
 - f. Hazardous Material or Explosive Material Transporter (HAZMAT) – Requires completion of Hazmat transportation course or Explosive material transportation course
5. Failure to maintain a valid state driver's license or to sign the OF-346 will lead to your endorsements being revoked.
