Sea Duty for SWE eligibility and Sea duty points_ For eligible sea time criteria see 5-C-15 of the Personnel Manual for credible award point(s). Accrual of sea points starts with sea pay units served aboard from 1 Feb 94 up to the eligibility date. 1 month = .167 pts for all FULL months(30 days) of eligible Coast Guard sea time earned since 1 Feb 94. Round off to the nearest hundredth. **Maximum credit is 30 points.**

Time in Service_ Point credit based on 1 point per year figured to the TED, based on years and mos as reflected on your PDE. **Maximum credit is 20 points.**

Time in Rate/Present Paygrade_ Point credit based on 2 points per year figured to the TED, based on years and mos as reflected on your PDE. **Maximum credit is 10 points.**

Performance Factor_ point credit based on a calculation of your performance factor avg, as reflected on your PDE. **Maximum credit is 50 points.**
