Subj: PRECEPT CONVENING A CONTINUATION BOARD TO RECOMMEND
REGULAR LIEUTENANTS OF THE COAST GUARD ON THE ACTIVE DUTY
PROMOTION LIST FOR CONTINUATION

1. Pursuant to the authority provided by reference (a) and reference (b), a Continuation Board is appointed consisting of yourself as President and the following members:

2. Subsequent to the selection of officers to be recommended for promotion to lieutenant commander as specified in reference (c), the Board shall reconvene at 0800, 30 Mar 2016, in suite 4K15-16, Coast Guard Headquarters, or as soon thereafter as practicable, for the purpose of recommending regular officers of the Coast Guard on the Active Duty Promotion List in the grade of lieutenant for continuation on active duty. The Board shall recommend for continuation, on a best qualified basis, up to one less than the number of the eligible officers provided for consideration who are above zone, regular officers in the grade of lieutenant, who have at least twice failed of selection for promotion to lieutenant commander, and who have less than 18 years of active service as of 30 June 2016.

3. The term of service for any officer recommended will be for not less than 2 nor more than 4 years. The Chief, Officer Personnel Management Division will determine the length of the continuation for each officer recommended. However, no officer who has twice failed of selection will be retained beyond the last day of the month in which 20 years of active service are completed.

4. Prior to the date the Board submits its report, the Commander, Coast Guard Personnel Service Center, is authorized to delete the name of any officer whose name is removed from the Active Duty Promotion List for any reason. In the event any officer in the continuation zone established herein is removed prior to the date the Board submits its report, the Commander, Coast Guard Personnel Service Center will provide additional instructions. Any communications to the Board by any officer under consideration will be transmitted under separate cover.
5. Members of the Board shall swear or affirm that they will, without prejudice or partiality and having in view both the special fitness of officers and the efficiency of the Coast Guard, perform the duties imposed upon them, and that they will not disclose their proceedings to any person not a member of the Board.
6. The Board shall refer to the provisions of Sections 3.A and 6.A of reference (b) and the enclosed Commandant's Guidance to PY16 Officer Selection Boards and Panels in your development of criteria for determining the officers recommended for continuation. Additionally, section 6.A.3 of reference (b) provides four factors to consider in developing your criteria: performance, professionalism, leadership, and education.
7. You should emphasize to the members of the Board the importance of their obligation to confine themselves to facts of record and not predicate judgments on rumor or hearsay. At the end of your deliberations, all members must be able to say that the officers recommended for continuation are, in the opinion of least a majority of the members if the board has five members, or in the opinion of at least two-thirds of the members if the board has more than five members, the best-qualified to carry out the duties and responsibilities of the grade for which they are continued.
8. The Board shall submit a report in writing signed by all members of the Board. Except for the report of this Board, the proceedings of the Board shall not be disclosed to any person not a member of the Board. You will direct the members of the Board that their recommendations shall be kept confidential until the Commandant approves the report on behalf of the Secretary.
