1. PSC-EPM-2 and CG-751 have identified the CGC DAUNTLESS in Galveston, TX to become the second 210 WMEC in its class to convert to a mixed gender crew for upcoming Assignment Year 2014 (AY14). This message is to solicit tour complete enlisted women for early slate consideration of assignment to CGC DAUNTLESS.

2. Background: IAW REF A thru D, the Coast Guard has established a commitment to diversity across a full spectrum of gender, ethnic, and racial categories. There is an identified need for a focused effort in creating additional afloat opportunities for enlisted females, particularly within the 210 WMEC community.

3. Eligibility: all interested tour complete females, females above the cut for advancement, or in a pay grade to billet mismatch should consider this unique opportunity for their next assignment. The following anticipated AY14 position vacancies onboard CGC DAUNTLESS are listed below:
