A. Officer Accessions, Evaluations, and Promotions, COMDTINST M1000.3 (series)

1. A Regular to Reserve Commission Appointment Panel is scheduled to convene on 15 October 2014 to consider current and former regular Coast Guard officers for a commission in the Coast Guard Reserve.

2. Current Coast Guard officers wishing to apply for consideration should visit: <http://www.uscg.mil/psc/rpm/rpml/R2R.pdf> for instructions on how to apply via Direct Access (DA).

3. Officers separated within one year with an unqualified resignation or separated within two years under the Temporary Separation program must apply in writing. Requests for those officers should be forwarded via e-mail to: [arl-pf-cgpssc-rpm-boardspanels\(at\)uscg.mil](mailto:arl-pf-cgpssc-rpm-boardspanels(at)uscg.mil) to be considered.

4. Officers currently on active duty that apply must obtain a physical that meets retention standards recorded on a DD-2697 prior to separation. Failure to do so may cause a delay in accession and a break in service. Officers previously separated, if reserve affiliation has been approved, will be provided guidance on how to complete their accession through separate correspondence.

5. Applications must be received no later than 6 October 2014. All applicants are encouraged to review their official electronically imaged-personnel data record (EI-PDR) to verify their record prior to the panel's convening.
