




Sexual Assault Prevention and Response Military Campaign Office

Mission: The Sexual Assault Prevention and Response Military Campaign Office (SAPR MCO) is a strategically focused office responsible to rapidly operationalize and implement the Coast Guard's Sexual Assault Prevention and Response Strategic Plan.

Execution: The Sexual Assault Prevention and Response Military Campaign Office is responsible for the rapid implementation of near-term strategies that will create the processes, training regimens, measurements, and support system integrity that will best position the service to achieve the ultimate goal of eliminating sexual assault from the Service.

Organizational Relationships: The Sexual Assault Prevention and Response Military Campaign Office reports to the Deputy Commandant for Mission Support and collaborates with the SAPC, its subcommittees and the SAPR Program Office.

- The SAPR Program Office remains the point of contact for day-to-day management of the Sexual Assault Prevention and Response Program.
- The SAPC and its subcommittees are responsible for establishing and implementing the long-term strategies to eliminate sexual assault from the Coast Guard.
