SUSPENSION ORDER

On April 23, 2002, the parties submitted a Motion for Approval of a Settlement Agreement and Entry of a proposed Consent Order to be approved as a settlement of the case under 33 CFR 20.502. The Settlement Agreement was approved and incorporated by reference by Consent Order issued on April 25, 2002. Under the terms of the Settlement Agreement, the Respondent's license was suspended for three (3) months with two (2) months stayed on probation for twelve (12) months provided the Respondent complete an approved Bridge Management Course within two (2) months from issuance of the Consent Order. The Respondent was to serve an outright suspension of one (1) month.

On June 15, 2002, the U.S. Coast Guard, MSO New Orleans, LT(jg) Joni Clifton, IO filed a Notice of Failure to Complete Settlement Agreement stating that the Respondent has not supplied evidence of successful completion of the terms of the Settlement Agreement. THEREFORE, the Respondent has failed to comply with the terms and conditions of the approved Settlement Agreement.

ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Respondent's license is **SUSPENDED OUTRIGHT** for **TWO (2) MONTHS** as provided by the approved Settlement Agreement signed by the parties on April 8, 2002.
