The Settlement Agreement on the drug case, CG S&R 01-0704, requires a 13 to 14 month outright suspension of the Respondent's U.S. Coast Guard issued license number 877800, if all the terms of the Settlement Agreement are reached, otherwise the Coast Guard issued license will be revoked. The 6-month outright suspension for the negligence case, CG S&R 01-0677, is merged into that timeframe.

Respondent will have to comply with all the necessary conditions of the Settlement Agreement for Drug Use or Addiction, to establish that he has complied with the drug rehabilitation program satisfactorily, before his Coast Guard issued license number 877800 will be returned to him.
