**MEMORANDUM OF POST HEARING TELECONFERENCE AND AMENDED
ORDER**

On motion of Respondent's counsel, the parties and the undersigned participated in a post-hearing teleconference to discuss technical amendments to the DECISION AND ORDER issued July 21, 2008.

Respondent's counsel advised that the twelve (12) month period of outright suspension should start March 4, 2008, the date Respondent deposited his expired license with the Coast Guard.

Since 46 CFR 5.567(e) provides that "[t]he time of any period of outright suspension ordered does not commence until the license . . . is surrendered to the Coast Guard," the July 21, 2008 Decision and Order is amended to reflect that Respondent's outright suspension started on March 4, 2008.

WHEREFORE,

AMENDED ORDER

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that Respondent Paul Scott Hutchinson's license and all other documents held by Respondent are **SUSPENDED** outright for a period of twelve (12) months, said term of outright suspension shall commence on March 4, 2008, the day he deposited his license with the Coast Guard.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that service of this **AMENDED ORDER** on the parties and/or parties' representatives serves as notice of appeal rights set forth in 33 CFR 20.1001-20.1004 which were enclosed as Attachment C to the July 21, 2008 **DECISION AND ORDER**. The thirty (30) day period shall run from this date.
