



CG INSTITUTE CHANGES

The Institute lost one warrant billet in 2008 and therefore will only receive one new warrant this season. Additionally, it is shifting the Master Chief billet from the Resource Support Section to the Registrar's Office Division. The shift is being made to place more of an emphasis on ACE credit reviews of Coast Guard training.

Due to the loss of the billet and the move of the Master Chief billet, the Institute will reduce its divisions from six to four. The Tuition Assistance Division will combine with the Grants and Special Projects Division to form the Tuition Assistance and Grants (TAG) Division. The Non-Resident Training Division will combine with Resource Support to form the Course Support and Testing (CST) Division. Both changes will take effect 1 June.

2010 ESO SYMPOSIUM

The 2010 ESO Symposium will be 23-26 August at the Embassy Suites in Norman, Oklahoma. Monday the 23rd is intended to be primarily for the full time ESOs. Collateral duty ESOs and CDAs are encouraged to attend starting on Tuesday the 24th. The agenda specifics are still being put together. The intent is to have concurrent sessions that appeal to both the full time ESO and are helpful to the collateral duty ESO. Though not all of the specifics are known as we continue to adjust the schedule based on replies of invited guest speakers and presenters, I can state that all of the sessions offered in the Institute's ESO Orientation course for new ESOs will be offered during the symposium. I would encourage any ESO who has not attended one of the orientation courses to take advantage of that tract at the symposium.

The symposium is also an opportunity for ESOs to meet with representatives from colleges to learn about their specific programs and opportunities.

2010 EDUCATION SERVICES OFFICER OF THE YEAR

It is the intent to announce the 2010 Education Services Officer of the Year on Thursday 26 August. Though the ALCOAST has not yet been released for this award, it is making its way through the process. When it is released, it will most likely look very similar to last year's message.
