

1. In accordance with references (a) through (c), your request contained in reference (d) is approved.
2. A comprehensive and thorough two-panel review of your request was completed to ascertain that your waiver request was matched against service need to determine the validity of granting a waiver extending your involuntary retirement date. Based on the two-panel process, a service need exists and your retirement date is extended to **1 July 2012**.
3. You will no longer be eligible for Servicewide competition based on an approved retirement. However, your retirement approval will be categorized as an Involuntary Retirement to safeguard the possibility of advancement off the May 2010 Servicewide eligibility list.
