

Subj: PRECEPT CONVENING A SELECTION BOARD TO RECOMMEND
COMMANDERS OF THE COAST GUARD ON THE INACTIVE DUTY
PROMOTION LIST FOR PROMOTION TO THE GRADE OF CAPTAIN

(b) 14 U.S.C. § 729

(d) CG Personnel Manual, COMDTINST M1000.6A

1. Pursuant to the authority provided by reference (a), a Selection Board is appointed consisting of yourself as President and the following members:

CAPT Maureen M. Steinhouse, USCGR – Member
CAPT Webster D. Balding, USCG - Member
CAPT Mark S. Mackey, USCGR – Member
CAPT John S. Leyerle, USCGR – Member
CAPT Kurt B. Hinrichs, USCGR – Member

LCDR John E. Padgett, USCGR - Non-voting Recorder

2. The Board shall convene at 0830, 13 July 2009, in suite 501, Coast Guard Personnel Service Center, or as soon thereafter as practicable, for the purpose of considering all officers on the inactive duty promotion list in the grade of commander who are eligible for consideration for promotion to the grade of captain in the Coast Guard Reserve. Members of the Board shall swear or affirm that they will, without prejudice or partiality, and having in view both the special fitness of officers and the efficiency of the Coast Guard, perform the duties imposed upon them, and that they will not disclose their proceedings to any person not a member of the Board.

3. There is hereby established a promotion zone of 23 commanders on the Inactive Duty Promotion List consisting of the most senior officer in the grade of commander, namely, Commander Gregory S. Lingle, USCGR, and those 22 officers junior thereto, through and

including Commander William G. Rospars, USCGR. The names and records of all officers to be considered for promotion shall be furnished to the Board. The nine (9) best qualified officers shall be recommended for promotion.

4. References (b) and (c) authorize, when the needs of the service require, the consideration of officers for promotion from below the promotion zone. There are 29 eligible officers below the zone. One (1) officer from below the zone may be selected out of the nine (9) best qualified.

5. Prior to the date the Board submits its report, the Commander, Coast Guard Personnel Service Center, is authorized to add or delete the name of any officer from the Inactive Duty Promotion List for any reason. In the event any officer in the promotion zone established herein is added to or removed prior to the date the Board submits its report, the Commander, Coast Guard Personnel Service Center will provide additional instructions. Any communications to the Board by any officer under consideration will be transmitted under separate cover.

6. The Board shall refer to the provisions of Sections 5.A and 14.A of reference (d) and the enclosed Commandant's Guidance to PY10 Officer Selection Boards and Panels in your development of criteria for determining the officers recommended for selection. Additionally, section 14.A.3 of reference (d) provides four factors to consider in developing your criteria: performance, professionalism, leadership, and education.

7. You should emphasize to the members of the Board the importance of their obligation to confine themselves to facts of record and not predicate judgments on rumor or hearsay. At the end of your deliberations, all members must be able to say that the officers recommended for promotion are, in the opinion of at least a majority of the members if the board has five members, or in the opinion of at least two-thirds of the members if the board has more than five members, the best qualified to carry out the duties and responsibilities of the grade for which they are selected.

8. The Board shall submit a report in writing signed by all members of the Board. Except for the report of this Board, the proceedings of the Board shall not be disclosed to any person not a member of the Board. You will direct the members of the Board that their recommendation shall be kept confidential until the Secretary approves the report on behalf of the President, and the name of the officer selected for promotion is released to the Service at large.
