The Coast Guard Band presents a selection of favorite film scores in the thirteenth edition of the Movie Madness series. The concert offers a brief retrospective of the career of John Williams with two works written almost forty years apart. *The Reivers*, premiered in 1969, is based on the Nobel-prize-winning final novel of William Faulkner; Assistant Director CWO3 Richard E. Wyman conducts with special guest narrator Uncle Joe “Yo Yo” Zimmerman. Director CDR Kenneth W. Megan leads the ensemble in the latest score from the Indiana Jones series, *Indiana Jones and the Kingdom of the Crystal Skull*.

MU1 Lisa Williamson and the Masters of Swing perform a collection of Oscar-winning songs. The concert closes with highlights from Disney’s modern classic, *Beauty and the Beast*.
