Other activities include games for children, tours and an annual open house/ice-cream social. All events throughout the day will be free and open to the public.

The concert is presented in an innovative format, with separate small and large ensembles placed throughout the hall. From a small fife and drum group to the full contingent of the Coast Guard Band, from the Revolutionary War to present-day conflicts, the music spans our nation's history in battle. Featured works include Aaron Copland's *Fanfare for the Common Man*, the *American Civil War Fantasy*, which includes the stirring "Battle Hymn of the Republic," with the versatile and talented Musician 1st Class Lisa Williamson as soprano soloist. Film highlights of the Coast Guard's response to Hurricane Katrina are screened with a live soundtrack of "God Bless the USA." The United States Coast Guard Dixieland Jazz Band and the Masters of Swing play medleys from the First and Second World War eras.
