The Dixieland Jazz Band has entertained audiences across America, in the former Soviet Union in England, and in Japan. Notable venues include the open-air theater in Disney World, the Boardwalk in Atlantic City, the Embarcadero in San Francisco, the John F. Kennedy Center Millennium Stage in Washington, D.C., at the Sacramento, Sun Valley (Idaho), and Galaxy (Milwaukee) Jazz Festivals, and at Mardi Gras in New Orleans.
