On Sunday, January 14 at 2 p.m. in Leamy Hall Auditorium, the United States Coast Guard Band and Commander Kenneth W. Megan present an assortment of scores from decades of film. A screening of Laurel and Hardy's 1929 short, *Double Whoopee*, is accompanied by a silent film era chamber group. Laurence Olivier directed *Henry V* in 1944 and asked composer William Walton to score the film—Olivier later said that the music made the film a success. Indeed, it earned Walton an Oscar nomination and Olivier an honorary Academy Award for bringing the film to fruition. Also on the program is Michael Kamen's swashbuckling music to *Robin Hood: Prince of Thieves*, and *Streisand!*, a medley from the legendary diva's greatest roles, with Musician 1st Class Lisa Taylor as soprano soloist.
