LCDR MacCumbee has served as Facilities Engineer at Base Portsmouth since July 2011. He is responsible for all maintenance, construction, safety and environmental compliance at the 180 acre, 480,000 square foot Base that supports 23 tenant Commands including homeport for 11 Cutters.

LCDR MacCumbee graduated with a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering from the U.S. Coast Guard Academy and was commissioned in May of 2000. Assigned to the CGC JARVIS, he served as an Engineer-Officer-in-Training and Damage Control Assistant.

In December 2003, LCDR MacCumbee earned a Master's of Science in Civil Engineering from the University of Illinois. Following graduation, he reported to Civil Engineering Unit Providence where he served as design and construction project manager leading 22 facility projects worth \$12M in support of operations in the First District.
