1. This message is to provide instruction to all enlisted women that desire to compete for an afloat assignment in AY14. EPM is directing enlisted women who are requesting any afloat positions on their respective shopping lists to submit their E-Resume prior to 23 October 2013. This submission process will achieve the following:

A. Provide preliminary identification of candidate pools across all ratings to align berthing vacancies with open positions onboard cutters at one fixed point in time at the beginning of the assignment season.

B. Improve EPM's ability to address AY14 unit Command Concerns regarding berthing availability and gender diversity.

C. Provide parity in the assignment process by better aligning member desires with the available berthing and positions for assignment.

2. Women who are tour complete or anticipate being above the cut for advancement that desire an afloat assignment in AY14 should:

A. Access the Women Afloat Portal, REF C or contact MKC Claflin, the Women Afloat Coordinator, as soon as possible to discuss afloat opportunities and berthing availabilities.

B. Contact their respective Assignment Officers for career counseling before 30 August 2013.

C. Complete their E-Resume prior to 23 October 2012 IAW REF A. The AY14 shopping list is scheduled to be published on or about 01 October 2013 IAW REF B. Women who are considered sea duty candidates, need sea time to advance, or highly desire an afloat assignment should prioritize cutters at the top of their E-Resume in order to increase their competitiveness for each cutter assignment.

3. Enlisted women who desire to compete for the CGC DAUNTLESS mixed gender conversion should place the open DAUNTLESS positions as their first choice on their E-Resume IAW REF D.

4. Further guidance, FAQs, and updates are provided in the Assignment Tools Tab of REF C, the EPM Women Afloat Portal. The Portal will be used to provide the most up-to-date information and should be regularly accessed for information.

5. Commands are reminded that IAW REF B, Command Concerns are due to EPM NLT 16 August 2013. However, specific requests to convert cutters to mixed gender crews will be analyzed during the preliminary E-Resume process to determine the feasibility of any additional new conversions or berthing adjustments. The Women Afloat coordinator will consult with cutter Commands to identify these potential conversions or adjustments.
