

CAPT VIVIAN REECE HARNED USCGR RET

CAPT REECE died Sunday morning 17 July following a short illness. She was the last of the Three Angels, Vivian, CAPT Jeanne Gleason and CWO Betty Splaine. They were strong promoters of the Coast Guard and the Coast Guard Reserve.

CAPT Harned served in the DC area Coast Guard reserve units and was mentor to many, many Washington area reservists.

She was a staunch supporter of the Council Annual Holiday Party; always resplendent in her formal dress uniform.

CAPT Harned joined ROA in 1946 and in that time was not only a great supporter of ROA, but also a great leader. Served as president of the DC Coast Guard ROA Chapter and served many years on its executive committee. She spent many years as Alaska's Department National Councilman; from 1977-1978 she was the National Vice President for Naval Services; and in addition to many ad hoc committees, she served on the Rules, Public Affairs and Department and Chapter Development Committees.
