

Northern Virginia Senior Olympics in September- Contestants and Officials Wanted

The 2011 Northern Virginia Senior Olympics (NVSO) will take place 17 through 28 September at 18 venues throughout Northern Virginia.. Adults 50 years of age and over who live in one of the sponsoring jurisdictions are eligible to participate. Sponsoring jurisdictions are Arlington, Fairfax, Fauquier, Loudoun and Prince William Counties and Alexandria, Fairfax and Falls Church Cities. Events are broken down in 5, 10, or no age groups. Age groups for all doubles and team competitions will be determined by the age of the youngest participant. All substitutes must be within the same age group or older. All substitutes must be registered and have paid all fees to be eligible to participate.

Historic Ships Receives Grant for USCGC TANEY Deck Repair

Historic Ships in Baltimore was recently awarded a \$48,000 grant from the Maryland Heritage Areas Authority for the restoration and preservation of the fantail deck of USCGC TANEY. This area of the ship is in need of critical repairs to maintain her structural integrity and to keep the fresh water out of the vessel's interior spaces. The grant requires a 1:1 match so Historic Ships needs to raise an additional \$48,000 by October 7th or run the risk of losing the MHAA funding. Your assistance is greatly appreciated.
