

BILL IN CONGRESS WOULD MAKE COAST GUARD RETIREES ELIGIBLE FOR ARMED FORCES RETIREMENT HOME

On 7 May 2010, the Senate passed the Coast Guard Authorization Act for Fiscal Years 2010 and 2011, HR 3619. The Bill now waits further action in the House of Representatives. There is a provision in the Bill that would make Coast Guard enlisted and warrant officer retirees eligible to live in one of the two Armed Forces Retirement Homes in the United States (Washington, DC and Gulfport, MS). Funding for this program would come, in part, from up to \$1.00 being withheld each month from the pay of all active duty enlisted personnel and warrant officers.
