



LCDR Jamie Stall-Ryan CHC USN

A native of Northampton, Massachusetts, Chaplain Stall-Ryan enlisted in the Navy in September 1985 and served for seven years as an Operations Specialist. His tours of duty include USS Spiegel Grove LSD 32, SBU 24, USS KIDD DDG 993, CINCLANTFLT. In August 1992 he honorably separated from active duty to attend St. Hyacinth College and Seminary. In May 1996 Chaplain Stall-Ryan graduated with a BA in Philosophy. In August of 1996 he enrolled at Gettysburg Lutheran Seminary. In May 2000 he graduated with a Masters of Divinity. Upon graduation, the ELCA assigned him to the Greater Milwaukee synod where he served as Associate Pastor at St. Mary's Lutheran Church in Kenosha.

After returning to active duty in December 2003 Chaplain Stall-Ryan served as Command Chaplain aboard the USS CLEVELAND LPD 7. In December of 2005 he transferred to 2nd Marine division as the Battalion Chaplain for 1st Battalion 6th Marines, serving nine months in Ramadi, and as Battalion Chaplain for 2nd Amphibious Assault Battalion. In June of 2008 he transferred to the United States Naval Academy where he served for three years. In July of 2011 he went unaccompanied to NAVCENT/ 5th FLEET for one year.

Chaplain Stall-Ryan's personal awards include the Navy Commendation Medal (two awards), the Navy Achievement Medal (two awards), and other various service and unit awards.

He married the former Sara Stall of Melbourne, Florida in June 2000. They have two sons, Jonathan and Adam. They currently reside in Acton, Massachusetts.
