### Checklist for this item

	Your emergency instructions must either be posted in conspicuous locations accessible to the crew or kept readily available in lieu of posting.
	The emergency instructions must identify at least the following information, as appropriate for the vessel:
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The location of the survival craft.</li></ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• The survival craft each crewman is assigned.</li></ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Fire, emergency and abandon ship signals.</li></ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• If required the location of the immersion suits.</li></ul>
	Illustrations of how to don immersion suits.
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Procedures for making a distress call.</li></ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• A station bill which lists essential actions to be taken by each individual in an emergency</li></ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Procedures for rough weather at sea, crossing hazardous bars, and flooding.</i></li></ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Procedures for anchoring the vessel</i></li></ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Procedures to be used in the event an individual falls overboard.</i></li></ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• <i>Procedures for fighting a fire.</i></li></ul>
