She is very involved in Recreational Boating Safety and has conducted over 268 Recreation Boating Safety Partner Visits, as well as 30 Vessel Examinations so far this year. Marilyn also finds time to teach Safe Boating Classes to kids at the local schools.

Marilynn has been heavily involved in Public Affairs and was appointed as the assistant Public Affairs Officer at Group Port Angeles, as well as being assigned to be a member of the Group Port Angeles Public Affairs Team. She was the coordinator for the Group Port Angeles Veterans Day Program in 2008. Marilyn is the Division 4 coordinator for the Citizen Action Network (CAN) in the area. She has also been flying photo mapping missions for the Air Station.
