Amos Leviant is a member of Flotilla 24 (Seattle-Elliott Bay) and lives in Bellevue. Amos currently is the Flotilla Staff Officer for Vessel Examinations (VE) and is qualified as an ATON Verifier, Coxswain, Interpreter, Marine Dealer Visitor and a Vessel Examiner for the Auxiliary.

Amos has been actively involved in the training and mentoring of Vessel Examiners and his Flotilla has a total of 15 active Vessel Examiners. He has been highly successful in coordinating VE Days in the Seattle area at Shilshole Bay, Elliott Bay and Jim Day Marinas. Flotilla 24 conducted 150 vessel examinations on recreational boats at these events. Flotilla 24 has conducted 174 vessel examinations to date in 2009 and Amos has completed 39 of them. District wide the Auxiliary has conducted 5,173 vessel examinations for 2009.

Amos has been operationally involved in a variety of underway patrols, including Maritime Observation, ATON, SAR, and Training with approximately 57 hours underway in 2009. He has also been utilized by the Coast Guard for his interpreter skills.
