

Established: The station was one of four new stations built in 1991 and was commissioned Jan. 29, 1991. The stations built around that time were to close the gap in Loran-C coverage in the mid-continent and were used to free aircraft from crowded air traffic lanes by letting them fly more direct routes.

The station is remotely monitored and controlled by Navigation Center Detachment in Petaluma, Calif.

What we do: Loran Station Havre is in a chain with other Loran stations to enable it to cover the North Central United States. The other Loran stations include Baudette, Minn.; Gillette, Wyoming; and Williams Lake, Canada. Loran Station Havre helps to increase air safety and save time and fuel for air travelers. The station is the latest in Loran-C station design and construction because of its remote control capability that enables one crewmember to handle malfunctions after normal working hours.
