The Auxiliary Pacific Area conference was held 08–09 November 2002. The conference gave me an opportunity to meet the new NACO, Bill Edgerton, and listen to his plans for the Auxiliary. Commodore Edgerton has a much different style from the last NACO and I personally look forward to the next two years. I have copies of the “2003 National Program for anyone who wants a copy. There was also a discussion about “Uniform District Standing

Rules” that National is drafting for adoption by the Districts. DCOs are in the process of commenting and recommending changes.

Capt Dave Hill, my boss from Washington, D.C., was also in attendance. He reiterated that the Auxiliary Manual is his top priority and he has detailed a member of his staff to do nothing else but “get the manual done.” He gave us some good news on the budget – now if we can just get Congress to give us the money. Finally, Capt Hill spoke about the importance of the Auxiliary to Homeland Security. Auxiliary support will be needed!

During the conference each DCO was asked to give reports to include their best practices. D17 reported that they held training on “Emergency Response to Terrorism” a course produced by Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA). It’s a course we will consider offering to Auxiliary members supporting homeland security and maybe to all to improve awareness to this threat.

## Patrol Order Management System (POMS)

We will begin the transition to POMS on 01 January 2003. Other than a face-lift to the CG-5132, you shouldn’t notice too many changes, except prompt payment of claims.

As information becomes available and/or changes need to be implemented, we will keep you in the loop.

As stated in our previous newsletter, your desired patrol dates should be submitted to DSO-OP via your FSO. The Patrol Schedule is made one month in advance. Submit your name, facility and your following 30 days of desired patrol days by the 15<sup>th</sup> of every month. Make any cancellations or additional desired patrol dates via Roger Johnson as well.


It is not clear when the revised form will be available on the National Auxiliary Web Site.

## VSC Decal Distribution

SUBJECT: VSC Decal 2003 Distribution

The Auxiliary National VSC Program will have approximately twice the number of Decals allocated in 2003 for distribution as we had available in 2002. Let's take advantage of this and get our people out to make 2003 a stand out year for vessel examinations.

During the years 2001 and 2002 we learned how critical the management of the VSC program is at the flotilla level. **It is imperative that each FSQ-VE place the correct number of decals into the hands of our VE's who understand the scope and importance of our VSC mission, and will fully utilize the decal allocation given to them.**

Our VSC mission continues to be "reaching out" and providing a "one on one" boating education to the recreational boater, and assuring that boats are properly equipped and maintained. Always emphasizing the quality and integrity of the Program. Remember, it's the quality of the VSC that saves lives on the water.

Ordering procedures to obtain 2003 Decals will be the same as last year. The **INITIAL ORDER** should be made by the **FC** utilizing the **(ONE TIME ONLY) SPECIAL ORDER FORM** attached (mail or fax acceptable). The initial quantity shipped will be determined based upon 100% of 2001 production.

DSQ-VEs and DCPs / SQ-VE's should order their "stand by" emergency back-up Decal allocations directly through ANSC.

Subsequent flotilla decal orders will revert back to our normal ordering procedures, with the FSQ- MA making order requests through ANSC.

To encourage "JOB ONE FIRST JOB", once you have a new VE that has been trained and qualified during CY 2003, 20 VSC decals can be ordered from ANSC for the new examiner (please specify on the order-"New VE"). This shipment will help augment decal supplies to flotilla's which are gaining new Vessel Examiners.
