

WATER SHUTTLE (revised 8 Jan)

Eligibility: Limited to USCG personnel on a **first-come, first-serve basis**. Includes CG active duty (& accompanied dependents), CG civilian employees, CG Reservists & Auxiliaries on-duty, CG contractors (accompanied by CG personnel), and anyone that the COTR determines to have official business. Requests for exceptions must be made in advance to the Contracting Officer's Technical Representative at 522-8264, X235.

Maximum passengers limited to **10**, plus crew of 2. **Final decision on determining the order of passenger arrivals rests with the Vessel Operator.**

Ship Rules:

- Listen to and *strictly* follow all orders issued by the Vessel Operator and crew.
- Do not embark or disembark until instructed by the Vessel Operator or crew.
- For the safety of all, please refrain from speaking to or otherwise distracting the Vessel Operator or crew during operation.
- Upon embarking, riders or their sponsors must present valid ID to the crew.
- No smoking.

Route/Schedule: Operates between Sand Island & Pier 4. In the event the shuttle becomes inoperative, a landside bus will operate between the two sites. This is not available to personnel that missed a ride. For accuracy, the **Aloha Tower clock** (visible from both piers) is the "official" timepiece for the launch. The schedule as follows:
