First Night Charleston Fireworks

A Special Local Regulation for the First Night Charleston Fireworks display will be in effect on December 31, 1999 from 11:30 p.m. Eastern Standard Time (EST) until January 1, 2000 at approximately 1:15 a.m. EST. The Special Local Regulation designates the following safety zone around the fireworks barge: bounded on the north by the 32-47.03' North latitude and on the south by the 32-46.65' North latitude. The border to the east is Shutes Folly and to the west is the downtown Charleston peninsula.

Vessels other than the fireworks barge and official patrol vessels are prohibited from entering the regulated area except as authorized by the Patrol Commander. All patrol vessels will monitor VHF-FM channels 16 and 22A.
