1:00 PM September 27, 2004

**INNER HARBOR OF PORT CANAVERAL, CANAVERAL LOCKS AND BARGE CANAL
ARE OPENED TO VESSEL MOVEMENT.**

Effective at 1300 (1:00 PM) Vessel movements are permitted within the inner harbor of Port Canaveral as well as to and from the Barge Canal. Hurricane Condition Zulu remains in effect, in that the other waterways remain closed to vessel traffic. The Coast Guard is currently conducting port and waterway surveys in order to reopen them as soon as possible. Mariners are reminded that Port Canaveral Ship Channel remains closed due to shoaling and Aids to Navigation discrepancies.

Owners and operators of vessels and facilities subject to the security regulations are reminded that required security measures must be in place before resuming operation, and that all breaches of security (down fences, required technology inoperative, etc.) must be immediately reported both to the National Response Center at (800) 424-8802 and the Coast Guard Integrated Command Center at (904) 247-7318.

The Captain of the Port safety zone remains in effect from Kings Bay, GA to Melbourne, FL. No vessels may enter or transit within this safety zone without the permission of the Captain of the Port.
