




**Marine Safety Information Bulletin

**SEVERE WEATHER ADVISORY**

The National Weather Service has issued a Severe Weather threat for areas of Southeast Texas for Tuesday through Friday. While severe thunderstorms will mainly pass to the North of the Golden Triangle area, isolated severe thunderstorms with heavy rainfalls of 9-10 inches are expected in the Jefferson and Orange County Areas through Thursday. Off shore winds of 30 knots or more can be expected as well.



The Captain of the Port (COTP) would like to remind the maritime industry to take precautionary measures with containment sites, oil drums and sumps in order to prevent any potential oil or hazardous materials incidents over the next several days.
