KCS Railroad Bridge Closure Mile 19.5 Neches River, Port Neches, TX

The KCS vertical lift railroad bridge at mile 19.5 on the Neches River will be closed for maintenance in the down position and inoperable for marine traffic from 6:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M. on Tuesday, June 4, 2013. Vertical clearance in the down position is 13 feet.

Facilities up-river from the bridge closure that may be affected include Chicago Bridge and Iron Company, Bo-Mac Contractors, APAC-Beaumont, and the Beaumont Yacht Club.

Affected vessels and facilities should plan accordingly. Up-to-date information will be available from the Vessel Traffic Service (VTS) Port Arthur at 409-719-5070 or on VHF channels 65A or 13.
