**Cancellation of Marine Safety Information Bulletin 08 - 10**  
**Four-hour Transfer Notice Requirements**

This bulletin cancels Marine Safety Information Bulletin 08-10, dated March 30, 2010, requiring mobile and fixed facilities, subject to Title 33, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Part 154, to notify the Coast Guard at least four hours in advance of an oil transfer.

Bulk liquefied hazardous gas facilities, however, subject to Title 33, CFR, Part 127, must continue to provide a minimum of four hours advance notice prior to transfers as required by Title 33, CFR, Part 127.1319. In addition, the COTP may require certain fixed or mobile bulk oil facilities, subject to Title 33, CFR, Part 154, to notify the Coast Guard at least four hours in advance of oil transfers, based on the criteria listed in Title 33, CFR, Part 156.118(a); facilities required to provide such advance will be independently notified.
