Effective 12:30 CDT, September 15, 2008, the U.S. Coast Guard Captain of the Port, Port Arthur, Texas, announced the following channel openings for the Port Arthur Captain of the Port zone:

1. Neches River: Open to traffic up to 16' draft.
2. Sabine River: Open to traffic up to 16' draft.
3. Sabine-Neches Waterway: Open to traffic up to 16' draft.
4. Gulf Intracoastal Waterway: Open to traffic from mile 290 to mile 191.
5. Calcasieu Waterway: Open to traffic up to 16' draft.

The Gulf Intracoastal Waterway from mile 290 (West Port Arthur bridge) to mile 317 (High Island) remains closed because of storm debris in the waterway.
