SECURITY ZONE

Sabine Pass (Cheniere) LNG Ship Basin

The Captain of the Port, Port Arthur, Texas, has established a temporary Security Zone to include the entire area of the new Sabine Pass (Cheniere) LNG ship basin. Unless involved in transportation, direct support, or logistics of liquefied natural gas (LNG) operations, no vessel may enter or remain in this zone without the permission of the Captain of the Port.

Creation of this Security Zone is necessary to ensure the security and integrity of the facility, and to protect the public. The temporary Security Zone is intended to eventually become a permanent Security Zone.
