Swing Bridge Closure
Highway 82 Sabine Lake Causeway
Sabine Pass, Texas

The swing span of the Highway 82 bridge across the southern end of Sabine Lake will be inoperable in the closed-to-navigation position from July 7, 2008, to July 26, 2008. During this period, maximum vertical clearance at the bridge in the closed position is 9 feet above mean high water.

This closure is necessary for crews to reverse the direction of the existing swing span to facilitate construction of a new, replacement swing span bridge adjacent to the existing structure.

During the 19 day period of this closure, mariners may wish to consider using alternate routes.
