Change in Homeland Security Threat Advisory Status

The purpose of this PSIB is to bring to the maritime community's attention today's Homeland Security Threat Advisory change from Orange (High) to Yellow (Elevated).

Waterfront facilities and vessel owners, operators, and agents are again reminded interim MARSEC 2 measures are available from the Coast Guard Captain of the Port. The MARSEC 2 operational measures were recently reviewed and validated by the Port Security Subcommittee. In order to minimize disruption to commerce and ensure the seamless implementation of these measures, appropriate facility and vessel representatives who are responsible for operations and security are strongly encouraged to obtain an advanced copy.

The measures may be picked up at the Marine Safety Office (MSO). In order to obtain the measures a [SSI declaration form](#) will be required. It can be completed on line or in person at the MSO. The MARSEC 2 measures will be available for distribution at the MSO during the week from 8 a.m. to 3 p.m. at 9640 Clinton Drive, Galena Park. No appointment is necessary. The MARSEC 2 measures may also be requested via e-mail at MSOHOUMDA@esunola.uscg.mil. Recipients of the PSIB should ensure appropriate company personnel are made aware of its contents.
