

**Explosive Loadout**  
**Additional Requirements**

1. The explosives being handled must not exceed the amount specified on the application. You shall comply with 49 C.F.R. Part 176-CARRIAGE BY VESSEL for this transfer.
2. Explosive loading or unloading operations are to be conducted during daylight hours only. If due to unforeseen circumstances there is a compelling reason to conduct operations after dark, you must first obtain permission from the U.S. Coast Guard Marine Safety Unit, Lake Charles, LA, before proceeding.
3. You shall ensure that all state and municipal permits and notification requirements have been accomplished.
4. On site security shall be established as necessary to prevent access of unauthorized personnel to the vessel and area.
5. You shall place “No Smoking” signs at the loading and unloading sites.
6. As a minimum, you shall adhere to 49 C.F.R. 176.164, Fire Precautions and Firefighting, for vessels carrying class 1 Explosives. For the Facility, there must be a minimum of two B-II fire extinguishers on the dock during loading and unloading operations.
7. Passengers are prohibited on board the vessel while transporting explosives.
8. You shall properly secure and segregate all explosives on the vehicle or vessel prior to departure from the facility.
9. In the event of inclement weather or an electrical storm, all loading and unloading operations shall cease.
10. You shall make a copy of this letter available at the transfer site during all loading and unloading operations of explosives.
11. The explosives shall be the last item on the vehicle or vessel and the vehicle or vessel shall depart immediately after the explosives are on board.
12. No hot work or source of flames is to be permitted on the facility during the loading or unloading of explosives.

13. No other placarded dangerous cargo shall be handled on the facility unless specifically approved by the Captain of the Port or representative.
14. At no time will the explosive shipment have other cargo worked above it.
15. Vehicles used to transport explosives shall be attended to at all times while on the facility.
16. At no time will detonators be stored with class 1.1 explosives. Class 1.1 explosives can only be loaded onto the vehicle in authorized magazines.
17. Provide proof of training for all personnel engaged in handling of hazardous material upon request by this office.
18. This permit is terminated if any of the conditions stipulated by the Captain of the Port are not met.
