

Hurricane Conditions

Five: Annual alert condition in effect from 1 June through 30 November. Unit plan is reviewed and updated.

Four: 72 hour alert. There is a tropical storm or hurricane in the Atlantic that is expected to make landfall within 72 hours. It's not certain where it will make landfall. Personnel are alerted that they are subject to recall.

Three: 48 hour alert. There is a good possibility that the approaching storm could make landfall in our area within 48 hours. Essential personnel not on leave or TAD are recalled, and personnel are assigned to flyaway crews. **The order to evacuate will be provided separately when deemed necessary by the Sector Commanding Officer.** If evacuating to a different location, notify Sector Corpus Christi by calling the Command Center at 361-939-6393. If there is no answer, personnel and their families should notify the military member's supervisor or Department Head.

Two: 24 hour alert. There's a good possibility that the approaching storm could make landfall in our area within 24 hours. Make final preparations for the storm. Aircraft are flown away to safe areas.

One: 12 hour alert.
