Safety Zone

No Wake/Minimum Steerageway

ICWW Mile 282, R&R Marine

The Captain of the Port of Port Arthur is establishing a temporary Safety Zone on the Sabine-Neches Waterway and the Intracoastal Waterway in the vicinity of, and one half mile either side of, R&R Marine during the launching and loading of the 275' x 100' newly constructed casino barge module . The Safety Zone is planned to extend from 06:00 a.m. CST, February 24, 2007, until 11:00 a.m. CST, February 24, 2007, but the actual times of the Safety Zone may vary depending on the actual schedule of operations. Vessel Traffic Service Port Arthur will announce actual times of the Safety Zone prior to commencement.

No vessel may transit the Safety Zone without permission of the Captain of the Port. Vessels requiring entry into or passage through the Safety Zone should request permission from the Captain of the Port through Vessel Traffic Service, Port Arthur. They may be contacted on VHF-FM Channel 65A, 16, or 13 or by telephone at (409) 719-5070.

Vessels receiving permission to transit through this Safety Zone will be required to maintain bare minimum speed and no wake. No meeting or passing will be allowed in the zone.
