

SEVERE WEATHER ADVISORY

The National Weather Service and the State of Texas Operations Center have issued a Severe Weather threat for areas of Southeast Texas for the coming weekend. While severe thunderstorms will mainly pass to the North of the Golden Triangle area, isolated severe thunderstorms with heavy rainfalls of 2-3 inches are expected in the Jefferson and Orange County Areas throughout the weekend. Off shore winds of 15 knots or more can be expected as well.



The Captain of the Port (COTP) would like to remind the maritime industry to take precautionary measures with containment sites, oil drums and sumps in order to prevent any potential oil or hazardous materials incidents over the weekend.
