### **Beaumont (Kansas City Southern) Railroad Bridge Neches River, mile 19.5 Beaumont, Texas**

**Beginning at 7:00 a. m. Monday, May 23, 2011, the lift span of the Beaumont (Kansas City Southern) Railroad Bridge will be closed in the down position for a period of 72 hours for replacement of the steel cables used to operate the lift bridge. The bridge will be restored to normal operation by 7:00 a.m. Thursday, May 26, 2011. During this period, the maximum vertical clearance of the bridge will be reduced from a lift span vertical clearance of 147 feet, to a fixed vertical clearance of 13 feet above mean low water.**
