Weather Advisory
Southeast Texas – Southwest Louisiana

Showers and thunderstorms are expected to move into Southeast Texas this afternoon, and move west into Louisiana through the late afternoon and evening. The primary threat is damaging winds, followed by large hail and isolated tornadoes.
